- There will be no charge for children under 5 years of age (once they are sitting on a parent's lap and not taking a seat).
- **Tickets will be limited to 2 per child.**
- Any tickets remaining on Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> December will be sold through the office on a first come first served basis.
